I am pleased to write this article feeling much better after a lengthy period in the Royal Surrey County Hospital. It appears I caught an airborne infection that attacked both lungs causing a serious decline in my health. I was ill with Covid over Christmas, and that weakened my immune system leaving me vulnerable to infection.

I reached a stage where I found it difficult to breath and move around. I reported to A & E and was immediately admitted. X-rays revealed extensive infection and complications. The doctors and staff pumped me with different antibiotics to grip the infection. It has taken a while to repel the infection and repair the damage, but careful and meticulous nursing has prevailed. I thank God for all who looked after me including the invisible teams who work in the hospital labs and seek to identify the particular infection.

After such a long stay, I have sampled every meal on the hospital menu and given the limited budget, was grateful for what I received - though my recurring dream was of a thick sirloin steak (with apologies to vegans).

I enjoyed interaction with several Christian doctors and staff, most of whom have left their homeland to look after us; thank God for them, all so dedicated and cheerful.

Finally, Linda and I would like to thank you for your prayers and get well wishes which has meant so much to us during a challenging time. I also wish to thank our churchwardens for sterling work done keeping the church functioning
