Dear Friends,

In September, we welcome you to our monthly hubs. What exactly are they about? The word hub



refers to a meeting point – in this case the Good Shepherd, The Sands - where there is a specific interest shared. In the **Pastoral Hub**, the Rector and Pastoral Team will be in attendance, and invite you to drop in and share confidentially any pastoral concerns you may have such as experiencing grief or relationship difficulties. Whilst we are not professional counsellors, we are able to listen and pray with you if that would help.
