Dear Friends,

Our pilgrim hub has been busy producing several leaflets and guides for pilgrims who visit our churches as they walk along the sacred pathways to the shrine of St. Swithin or Thomas A Beckett. So far, we have produced a leaflet and trail featuring



stained glass images of the blessed virgin Mary which all four churches in the parish of SPW have in common. The four churches also have a leaflet and trail of memorial plaques that tell interesting stories of love and devotion.

The latest leaflet includes the amazing sundial at Wanborough church and links with other churches outside the parish that also have sundials. Soon off the press is a guide entitled "Heroes at Rest" and focusses on the war graves in the churchyards of Seale and Wanborough.

In the planning stage we hope to find and link the Holy Wells of the diocese of Guildford, we were told there was once such a well at the Sands???. A series of guides with sacred songs, prayers blessings and readings for pilgrims will follow

There are many pilgrims who visit our churches and stamp their pass books with a patron symbol, we hope to help them through our leaflets and guides to discover more about our beautiful churches and to be inspired to find spiritual meaning and grace as they journey through our parish and beyond.
